

COMPANY POLICIES:

These are the policies for making purchases at Willems Landscape Service, Inc. Please take time to read through this section, particularly if you are a landscape contractor. If you have any questions regarding our policies, please feel free to ask.

<u>Warranties:</u> All plant material (except for perennials/annuals/as marked) are guaranteed for one full year from date of purchase. You <u>must</u> have your receipt and dead plant material to exchange for credit only. Returned plants will be inspected to determine acceptability. Warranties do not apply to *wholesale purchases*.

Estimates: Estimates are free, with no obligation to purchase items from our company. However, appointments fill up quickly, so plan accordingly. We reserve the right to solicit customer requests to other landscaping companies.

<u>Payment:</u> We do accept credit or debit cards, as well as cash or checks. We can also bill you if there are no outstanding debts with our company.

Wholesale Purchases: Owners will be required to provide proof of business ownership. Approved landscape contractors are entitled to a 20% discount. This discount does not apply to topsoil, garden mix or delivered items. Plant material is not warrantied when purchased wholesale. Failure to make payments in a timely matter will result in wholesale rights being revoked. A seller permit number/tax exempt number must be on file prior to making tax-exempt purchases. Contractors must be present with customers, as we are unable to take care of your customers. Discount is non-transferable (not extended to relatives, friends etc.). Failure to comply with these policies may result in revoking of wholesale status.

Past-due invoices will incur finance charge monthly after the first month, and every month after until the invoice is completely paid.

Maintenance Required For New Grass & Plants

For Seeded Lawns:

When planting seed, make sure the soil is not too compact. Loose soil consisting of particles from a quarter to one inch. Gently rake the seed into the topsoil, do not burry it. Your seeded lawn needs to be watered in each section for at least 30 minutes for proper saturation. Over-watering a seeded area can result in wash-out, so take care to monitor areas for standing water. After one month, the lawn is ready for its first cutting. Set the lawn mower at its highest setting when cutting for the first time. Subsequent cuttings can be lower, but remember that keeping the grass higher keeps the ground moist and the lawn greener and weed-free. Do not apply any weed killer for one year from the time of seeding. Follow the fertilizing schedule of once a month during the growing season from May-October. Use as starter fertilizer with an analysis 10-10-10 in the spring, then 10-10-10 each month, with a final application of 10-10-10 in the fall.

For Sod Lawns:

Sod requires a greater amount of water compared to seeded lawns. Keep the lawn well-saturated for 14 days after installation, until the grass roots into the existing ground. Watering sod areas for two hours every day will be adequate. It is almost impossible to over-water sod. Use impact-head sprinklers when watering for the best, most-even coverage when watering. You can reduce the watering after two weeks, and begin cutting if the grass is well-rooted to the existing soil. The grass in the sod is at least a year old, so it can be treated like a year-old established lawn for fertilizing. Follow the fertilizing schedule above for keeping your lawn healthy.

For New Shrubs:

Newly planted shrubs need watering about once a week. One gallon of water per week is sufficient for most situations. Put the hose close to the ground, to maximize water usage. Make sure the area is soaked with water, as various soil types require different frequencies and amounts of water. If planted by us, the shrub(s) will have been planted with a slow-release fertilizer that will fertilize the shrubs for a minimum of three years. Do not trim any live branches until the following year, preferably the following autumn. Any dead branches can be trimmed immediately after planting. Please see the pruning guide on the next page for more information. In the fall, watering can be less frequent, giving the tree one final watering before winter. The following year, it is not necessary to water the tree, as natural rain water should take care of the plant, except for unusually hot and dry weather. In these cases, follow the directions above until the period of drought has passed.

For New Trees:

Newly planted potted trees need to be watered about a gallon once a week, up to twice a week during hot, dry weather. Put the hose close to the ground, to maximize water usage. Make sure the immediate ground around the tree is saturated after each watering. Balled and burlapped trees need to be watered about five gallons once a month, or twice a month during hot and dry times of the year. If planted by us, the tree(s) have been treated with a slow-release fertilizer that will fertilize the tree for a minimum of three years. Do not trim any live branches until the following year, preferably the following autumn. Dead branches can be pruned at any time. In the fall, watering can be less frequent, giving the tree one final watering before winter. The following year, it is not necessary to water the tree, as natural rain water should take care of the plant, except for unusually hot and dry weather. In these cases, follow the directions above until the period of drought has passed.



Some tips for your comfort and safety

Wear comfortable, off-road type sports or hiking shoes or boots for gravel and mulch (flip-flops, high-healed shoes, open-toed shoes, or dress shoes are not recommended).

Strollers are fine if they have larger wheels, as skinny wheels have trouble pushing through the gravel or mulch parts of the yard.

We occasionally apply herbicides and pesticides to our plants, so be aware of sensitivities to these (we are required by law to apply control measures for weeds and pests).

Dress for the weather-Spring can be especially unpredictable-dress in layers and prepare for rainy weather.

You are welcome to drive through our sales yard, but please be aware of hazards & pedestrians. Please park your vehicle out of the way of traffic. Items can be loaded into your vehicle and brought to a check-out area such as our sales office or seasonal greenhouse.

How and When to Trim Shrubs and Trees

Maintaining Overall Shape

Prune to maintain overall shape of shrubs at any time of the year. This includes removing any dead or diseased branches or removing branches that extend beyond the desired shape of the plant. Keep in mind that not all shrubs have the same shape, and you should work to maintain the natural shape of the shrub. Weeping shrubs, like forsythia, have a natural arch to their branches and should not be trimmed to form a ball or rounded canopy.

Spring-Blooming Shrubs and Trees

Trim shrubs like forsythia, lilac and mock orange that bloom in spring or early summer directly after blooming. Spring-blooming shrubs set buds in mid- to late summer for the next year's blooms. Any pruning or trimming done after the first week of July my remove young buds and diminish blooms for the next season.

Summer- or Fall-Blooming Shrubs and Trees

Prune summer- or fall-blooming shrubs summersweet in early spring before new growth occurs. Summer-blooming shrubs bloom on new growth. Pruning in early spring promotes new growth and vigorous blooms.

Procedure

Use clean, sterile clippers when pruning or trimming shrubs. Dip clippers in asolution of one part household bleach to seven parts of water between cuts. Making a clean cut with sterile clippers reduces the risk of introducing disease in open cuts. Trim terminal shoots on a 45-degree angle about 1/4 inch above a bud. Sharp angles take longer to heal and increase the risk of exposure to disease. A 45° angle allows water to run off the cut, and encourages new growth to form from lateral buds 6 to 8 inches below the cut. Control the direction of new growth by selecting a lateral bud facing the direction in which you wish new growth to appear, and cut 1/4 inch above the bud. If two buds are present facing opposite directions, remove the bud that you do not want to grow.

Severe Pruning

Severely prune overgrown shrubs to rejuvenate and encourage lush new growth. Shear to the ground in early spring, if necessary. Yellow and red twig dogwood benefit from shearing nearly to the ground each year. This encourages new woody growth and creates a compact plant with showy wood.

Perennials

Cut the died-back plant completely to the ground in the fall. Some people enjoy the look of some perennials, such as ornamental grass in winter, so you may keep these up until spring, before the new growth immerges from the ground.


Evergreens

Evergreens such as boxwood, pine, spruce, cedar (arborvitae & juniper), holly, etc. can be pruned at any time during the growing season. You may want to avoid trimming evergreens during the hottest & driest time of the year (usually late August/early September).




Deer-Resistant Plants

Calculating Cubic Yardage





(There are roughly four and a half large wheelbarrows (6 cubic foot) per cubic yard), 6.75 30-gallon drums, or 13.5 2-cubic foot bags or 40 5-gallon pails

$1 \text{ CUBIC YARD} = 3' \times 3' \times 3'$

Average Coverage of 1 Cubic Yard

At This Depth (Inches)	Covers This Area (Square Feet)
1 " Deep	300 Sq Ft
2" Deep	150 Sq Ft
3" Deep	100 Sq Ft
4" Deep	75 Sq Ft

The formula looks like this:
Cubic Yards = $\frac{\text{(Length x Width x Depth)}}{27}$



If your beds have **weird shapes**, just separate them into rectangles!

If you have an area 100' x 4' (400 square feet), and want to put the material 3" deep:


Convert the depth into feet by dividing 3 by 12 (12"=1', so 3"=0.25').

Multiply the square footage area by the depth, 400x0.25=100.

Divide the total cubic footage by 27 to convert it to cubic yardage 100/27=3.71 (Round up to $3\frac{3}{4}$ cy).

This area needs roughly 3.75 cubic yards of stone/mulch/soil. Using the chart on the left, 1 yard covers 100 sf at 3" deep, so 400 sf so you would need 4 cubic yards.
